## Maggie's Racs ${ }^{\text {mu }}$

Topped with a drawstring ruffle and bow, and finished at the bottom with a petal ruffle, knit this very easy hat in daffodil yellow, lupine blue or foxglove pink. It's sure to suit every little girl's flower fantasy. Knit circularly, with absolutely minimal finishing from a doubled strand of worsted weight wool.

| Worsted Weight Yarn | 200 yds | 250 yds | 310 yds | 370 yds |
| $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{gr})=$ about 200 yds | $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{gr})$ | $4.4 \mathrm{oz}(125 \mathrm{gr})$ | $5.4 \mathrm{oz}(155 \mathrm{gr})$ | $6.4 \mathrm{oz}(185 \mathrm{gr})$ |

Needles: \#8 US (5mm) - 16" circular and \#8 US (5mm) - 24" circular, or size needed to achieve gauge. Size G ( 6 mm ) crochet hook.

Gauge: 16 sts $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$


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| INSTRUCTIONS | XS | S | M | L |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| USING A DOUBLE STRAND OF YARN and shorter needle, cast on _- <br> sts. Join ends of cast on row, being careful not to twist knitting. Working <br> circularly, knit until hat measures 2" $(5 \mathrm{~cm})$ long. On next round, *K2tog, YO*, <br> repeat between * around. | 52 sts | 60 sts | 68 sts | 76 sts |
| Continue knitting until hat is __ long. | $8{ }^{\prime \prime}(20 \mathrm{~cm})$ | 9 " $(23 \mathrm{~cm})$ | $10^{\prime \prime}(25 \mathrm{~cm})$ | $11^{\prime \prime}(28 \mathrm{~cm})$ |
| On next round, *K1, M1*, repeat between * around. Knit 2 rounds. | 104 sts | 120 sts | 136 sts | 152 sts |
| On next round, using longer needle, *K1, M1*. Repeat between * around. Knit <br> 2 rounds. Bind off. | 208 sts | 240 sts | 272 sts | 304 sts |

Using doubled yarn, crochet a chain 20" long. (You may also twist a cord out of yarn, or use i-cord). Weave this in and out through the eyelets at the top of the hat. Pull up tight, knot securely, and tie into a bow. Weave in any loose ends.

## OPTIONS

- Make a 14" cord and add a second bow just above the ruffle.
- Knit in green to eyelets, then change to flower color for rest of hat.
- Knit in green to ruffle, then change to flower color for ruffle.
- For infant size, add 8 " ties to either side.
- Use two strands of the same color, or two different colors. One or both can be variegated yarn.
- Change to a second flower color for ruffle.
- Use contrast color yarn for drawstring and bow.
