

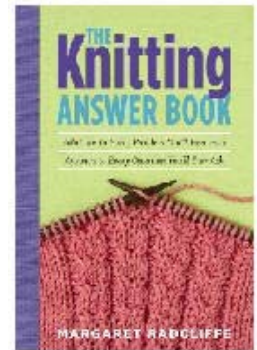


Maine Knitting Cruise
